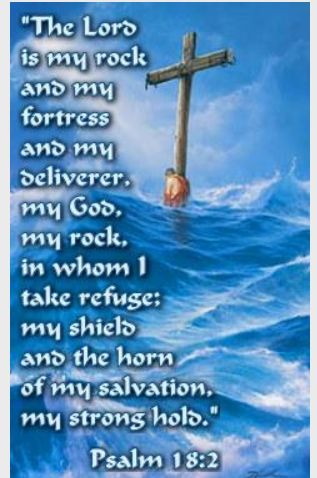
WELCOME BACK! We HOPE that YOU had a restful and fun-filled Easter vacation ☺
